FAVORITE SNORKEL SPOTS

Snorkel Spots: Starting SouthSide (*1) and working clockwise.

1. **Punalu'u-Black Sand Beach**, protected bay. **Swim with Honu!** (*)
2. **Honomalino Bay** - Black Sand, decent snorkling, requires a hike.
3. **Pebble Beach** - Black Stone Beach, snorkeling near edges of the bay. **Unique!**
4. **Ho'okena Beach** - limited parking, snorkling to the **RIGHT** in the bay. (*)
5. **Two-Step** - Local favorite snorkel spot. **Local spot.** (*)
6. **Kealekua Bay** - Requires a hard hike, snorkel cruise, kayak adventure. Maybe the best snorkling in the world here hard to get to though.
7. **Kamakahonu Beach** - Easy access from the beach at King K hotel. **Popular spot.** (*)
8. **Honokohau Beach** - Old Hawaiian Fishponds, historic area.
9. **Mahaiula/Kekaha Kai** - Rugged road, fairly quiet and good snorkling. (*)
10. **Kua Bay** - Great all-around beach and snorkling near the rock outcroppings. (*)
11. **Kukū'o Beach** - Visit guard shack for a Pass (limited #), walk to snorkel area. (*)
12. **Keawaiki Bay** - Hike a rugged trail to beach, usually you have this spot to yourself.
13. **Beach 69 (Waialea)**-Great snorkling, one of our fav go-to spots! (*)
14. **Hapuna & Mauna Kea** - Nice beach, ok snorkling.
15. **Spencer Beach park** - heralded as good snorkling, summer only.
16. **Mahukona** - an old dock/pier with good swimming and snorkling. **Unique!**
17. **Carlsmith Beach Park** - protected snorkel area, enter via concrete steps. (*)
18. **Richardson Ocean Park** - black sand bottom, nice snorkling, easy entrance. (*)

(*) Indicates if there is a toilet nearby
